
Emilia and Miguel

FIGHT BACK AGAINST SECONDHAND SMOKE








Emilia and Miguel were happy to see their cousins Daniel and Jessica, so they all played in the backyard. Grandma and Grandpa's dog Luna played too!


As Emilia started to open her second present, she saw Grandpa reach into his pocket for a cigarette.
